## **LRC Members League Rules**

- 1 To be eligible to win prizes, a horse/pony combination must attend a minimum of 3 competitions.
- 2 Members League points are awarded in the League classes, open to Ladyleys Riding Club members and non members.
- Horse/pony and rider combinations may compete in more than one league, if eligible, but may only score points in one league. If points are gained in more than one league, the points for the lower league will be forfeited. Points may not be transferred from one league to another or from one rider/horse/pony to another.
- 4 Horses/poines can compete with more than one rider in consecutive leagues.
- 5 Any horse/pony changing riders during the league will not carry forward any points previously gained with the previous rider.
- Juniors will be those who are under 18 years on 1st January in the current membership year (as per BRC rules). If eligible as a junior at the beginning of the Winter Show Jumping League, competitors may complete the Winter League in that class if they so wish, regardless of whether they become senior members on January 1st 2019.
- At or in the vicinity of any Ladyleys Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Hats marked EN 1384, PAS 015 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Hard hats to the specification of PAS 015 and ASTMF 1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN 1384. Recommended hard hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of kite mark or SEI American standard SNELL E95 and Australian/ New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable.
- 8 The wearing of body protectors is recommended for Adults but is Compulsory for Children
- Disclaimer of liability save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
- 10 Competitors, or their assistants, may not use the outdoor school to lunge their horses on the day of the competition.
- 11 Competitors are required to show courtesy towards others when warming up in the outdoor school. If riding on the opposite rein to one another competitors should pass left shoulder to left shoulder, and practice fences should be jumped in the correct direction.
- 12 The judge's decision is final.
- 13 The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above.
